Club de Golf Alcanada

Designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr., commissioned by the Porsche family, opened in 2003. Alcanada is considered one of the finest courses in Europe.

Golf Son Gual



Designed by Thomas Himmel, established 2007. Son Gual is one of the newest courses in Mallorca and one of the most desirable courses to play. Ryder Cup captain Ian Woosnam said, "It's a bit like Augusta. You've got to get the ball on the right side of the hole. Miss it on the wrong side and you're dead."

Canyamel Golf



Designed by José Gancedo, established 1988. Canyamel is one of the most picturesque courses on the island, with views towards Menorca. Its key feature is the gorgeous 18th hole with triple "piano" undulation, which can be observed from the terrace of the Club House, as if it was an auditorium open towards the mountains.

Golf Son Termes



Son Termes claims to be Mallorca's most ecological golf course, opened in 1998, designed by the Harris group and José Rodríguez.

Demanding golf in the foothills of the Tramuntana mountains challenges even practised players. The numerous water hazards are however also manageable by less practised players.

Arabella Golf: Son Vida

Son Vida is the most traditional and first course in Mallorca, opened in 1964 and has twice hosted the European Tour, featuring the likes of Severiano Ballesteros and Barry Lane.

Technical design, with fairways running through the residential area of Son Vida, requires an intelligent game strategy. Its stunning 18th hole par 5 with a second shot over the water is a delight for adventurous golfers.

Arabella Golf: Son Muntaner

Opened in 2000, designed by Kurt Rossknecht, Son Muntaner's fairways and greens were completely reseeded in 2016 and is among the best courses in Europe.

An extraordinary layout with water hazards and challenging greens are designed to make this a competitive course, with a difficulty rating of moderate to hard.

Club de Golf de Son Servera

Designed by John Harris & Francisco Lopez Segales, opened in 1967, this is the second oldest club on the island. The course lies below a range of pine clad mountains with glorious views over the bay of Cala Millor and is suitable for both experienced and novice players.
